

Frequently Asked Questions

Does my child need to wear Uniform?

Yes. This can be ordered from www.myclothing.com and details of this is in the admission pack.

What are the school holiday dates?

The school follows the East Sussex County Council Holiday and term dates. These can be found on the Southfield Trust website www.thesouthfieldtrust.com

What is the start time and finish time for Hazel Court School?

We open the doors at 8:50am and see the students out at 3:10pm.

Does the school have a dining hall to buy hot food?

Yes. Hazel Court School shares the dining hall with the Causeway school. We use the hall between 12:00 and 1:00 and pupils can choose from a range of hot meals and sandwiches. Pupils can also bring their own packed lunches which they can eat in the dining hall. Meals are paid for in advance through 'Parent Pay' and free school meals are provided for those that are entitled to this.

What will my child learn at Hazel Court School?

We follow a curriculum teaching Maths, English, Communication and Personal and Social Development to develop functional skills and independence. We work very closely with Parents and Carers to ensure that we are teaching the right things at the right time for our pupils to achieve the best outcomes for their future.

If my child receives therapy will this still continue?

If your child has direct input from the CITES therapy teams this will continue at Hazel Court School until the next review of the therapy needs.

Do the students get to go out into the community?

The learning at Hazel Court School aims to develop functional skills that pupils can transfer to a range of contexts. We visit the community regularly e.g. to go shopping or to practice leisure skills e.g. go to a café.

Where do the students move onto after Hazel Court School?

Hazel Court School provides education for pupils and students aged 11-19. Our pupils move to our FE Department at the end of Year 11 and. This is a natural progression and they do not need to apply for a place.
